The APICS computer science conference is currently accepting extended abstract submissions for the contributed talks and poster sessions on Saturday, October 23, 2009. Graduate and undergraduate students are particularly encouraged to submit their research work. It is a great opportunity to practice presentation skills, become known, and receive feedback. All student presentations will be evaluated and prizes will be awarded for the best student presentations and posters in computer science. Oral presentations are suited to mature research with concrete results, while posters are a better fit for research in progress. Graduate students and undergraduate students with recently completed NSERC Undergraduate Student Research Award assignments (USRA) are encouraged to submit abstracts.

Extended abstracts should be submitted electronically before September 10, 2009, to <http://www.easychair.org/conferences/?conf=apicscs2009>. Each abstract should include: Title, author names, affiliations and email addresses, and should not exceed 1000 words.
